Three \$1,500 scholarships

Must have plans to enter a college/university or vo-tech/certification program  
Must be a member of S.A.D.D.  
One \$1,000 scholarship

**Centralia Community Church Scholarship**  
Must have plans to enter a college/university or vo-tech/certification program  
Up to five \$500 scholarships

**Nemaha Central High School Seniors**
